**Regarding the Resumption of Classes from Temporary Closure of a School for the
Prevention on Novel Coronavirus (Notice)**

We sincerely hope that all parents and guardians had a good time because of the warm weather. More over, we would like to express our sincere gratitude and appreciation to each of you for securing the health, safety and protection of the students as your cooperation during the school holidays. We will continue to do our utmost contribution to the development of children, their safety and secure their School life, so we are asking for your continued understanding and cooperation.

In line with this, Ota City recognizes that the Novel virus will last for a long period of time and we take measures to prevent infection to ensure a healthy learning for children. We decided to start the educational activities in stages.

We will be responding in the future as follows:

1. School resumption date: June 1, 2020 (Monday).
2. Start (Plan) from resumption to return of regular classes:

* About delaying of learning and recovering lifestyle.

Everyday from short time classes to school, we will gradually return to regular class.

* For those children who have sickness and health concerns:

If it is difficult to attend the school, you may not go to school

(We will not consider it as absent).

<For Elementary school> After the second week, the Schedules will change depending on the situation of the school.

- 1st week (1st~5th day) Morning class • (no school lunch) • dismissal.
- 2nd week (8th~12th day) Morning class • (simple lunch) • dismissal.
- 3rd week (15th~19th day) Morning class • (lunch included) • about 1 hour class in the afternoon • dismissal.
- 4th week (22nd~26th day) Regular class • (lunch included).

<For Junior High School> Schedules will change depending on the situation of the school.

- We will divide the grade or class into two groups, start by attending School in the morning and afternoon.
- 1st week (1st~5th day) Morning and afternoon shifting classes (no school lunch).
- 2nd and 3rd week (8th~19th day) (simple lunch)
 - * Morning class: Class • after lunch • dismissal.
 - * Afternoon class: Lunch • class • dismissal.
- 4th week (22nd~26th day) Regular class (lunch included).
